

### **LONDON PRE-BOOKABLE MOORING** SURVEY - SUMMARY OF FINDINGS

29 August 2016

The online survey was carried out to help better understand what demand there may be for prebookable moorings in London. 1396 people responded to the survey between 15/06/16-26/08/16.

#### We asked 'Have you visited London on your boat?'

Yes: 73% (1015) No: 27% (380)

#### We asked those who had visited 'when was the last time you visited London on your boat?'

#### We asked 'What was the primary purpose for your visit?'

On a private mooring (free)	6% (56)

#### We asked those who said they had not visited 'What was the main reason for not visiting London?'

I did not want to visit London because I wanted to cruise elsewhere 15% (47) I wanted to visit London but was not certain I would be able to find a place to moor 85% (278) Did not answer 55

#### We asked 'What kind of boater are you?'

A boater who continuously cruises 33% (377)

#### We asked 'How long have you had a boat?'

Less than a year 5% (56)
1-3 years 20% (236)
4-5 years 14% (161)
More than 5 years 60% (721)
Did not answer 222

## We asked 'Is there anything you think the Canal & River Trust could do to improve boating in London?'

923 people responded to this question. The following is a summary of the most frequent comments.

More facilities (water, pump out/elsan, refuse/recycling (215)

Create more mooring spaces / install more rings/bollards (190)

Better management of short-stay visitor moorings/stop overstaying (120)

More short-stay visitor moorings (115)

Reduce overstaying beyond the 14 day limit (98)

Introduce a bookable/guaranteed mooring (97)

Better enforcement of the rules (89)

Less mooring restrictions/keep more 14 day moorings (53)

Reduce the number of continuous cruiser boaters in London (49)

Create more offline permanent/residential moorings (32)

Increase the range of boat movement in London (32)

Improve infrastructure (including dredging/vegetation management) (23)

Improve communication/information for boaters (including signage) (21)

Make moorings safe and secure (20)

Remove unlicensed craft occupying moorings (16)

Stop three abreast mooring (13)

Slow cyclists on the towpath (11)

Reduce the amount of rubbish on the towpath/in the canal (11)
