# Information about the Moorings:

These moorings are located in the Lower Basin of The National Waterways Museum, South Pier Road, Ellesmere Port, CH65 4FW

**Google Maps - Lower Basin Pre-Bookable Moorings** 

The mooring is situated in the Lower Basin of the National Waterways Museum. Pedestrian access is via the gate to the lower basin below Porters Row may be used for access using a BWB key. Please be aware that the council controls access into Raddle Wharf, but it is usually accessible during normal working hours. BW Keys can be purchased at the Museum reception along with pumpout cards.

# **Boater Amenities**

#### **WATER POINT**

Drinking water taps are situated at the Main Entrance towpath gate, behind the Stable block and on the end of the workshop building in the Heritage Boatyard.

### **RUBBISH DISPOSAL**

A bin store is situated outside the Museum entrance, accessible with a BWB key.

### **ELSAN POINT**

An Elsan Point can be found in the Heritage Boatyard.

#### **TOILETS**

Toilets are situated in the Museum Reception building, on the Upper Floor of the Island Warehouse – please note, these will only be open during Museum opening hours.









### **Site Rules**

In addition to your license terms and conditions we do have some specific site rules:

- Craft must be licensed correctly and have a current Boat Safety Certificate and insurance.
- Only smokeless fuels may be burnt. Wood to be used for kindling only, no logs to be burnt.
- Dogs are permitted on site but **MUST** be kept on a lead at all times. Please be considerate and pick up after your pet.
- Smoking is not permitted in any of the Museum buildings.
- In the interest of fairness to all boaters should you encounter any problem with vacating the berth you must advise us immediately. If the moorings are not booked, you may extend your stay (up to a maximum of 7 nights). - We will make every effort to ensure that the mooring you have booked is available for you. If you find that someone has taken your space, please get in touch with us and we'll investigate and try to resolve the situation as quickly as possible.
