A Gold Licence can be more economical than separate licences from the different navigation authorities, depending on the length of time you intend to spend away from your home navigation on any of the waterways covered by the licence.

What is a Gold Licence?

The Gold Licence is for people who wish to spend time cruising on a combination of Canal & River Trust and Environment Agency (EA) navigations. EA navigations include the River Thames, Anglian waterways and Upper Medway: each of these areas has its own registration/licensing scheme.

The Gold Licence replaces the need for separate licences from the different authorities and covers all Canal & River Trust and EA navigations.

It is a twelve month licence and registration for powered craft only. It doesn't cover the tender to a boat – you need to register or license this separately with the individual authorities.

What does it cost?

If your boat is less than 2.16 metres wide, the cost is upward from £827.34 depending on its length. The fee sheet for boats under 2.16m wide is printed on page 4.

When is it available?

All Gold Licences run from 1 January and expire on 31 December, you may be eligible for a part year licence, these are only available for customers who have not previously held a Gold Licence and must be dated to start from the month the boat was entered in the water. If you have previously held a Gold Licence then your licence will be required to start on 1 January.

How can I get a refund on my current, unexpired licence or registration?

Your home navigation may issue a pro-rata refund for any overlapping months unused, should you upgrade to a Gold Licence.

You may be eligible for a pro-rata refund for your licence if you have sold the boat, taken the boat permanently off the water or placed the boat which is still afloat onto a trade brokerage. Refunds are for full months remaining only and are subject to a £30 admin charge.

Please note if you apply for a Gold Licence for the following year it will be required to start on 1 January.

Discounts

- Vessels which are powered solely by electricity: 25% discount.
- Canal & River Trust prompt payment discount is already deducted from the payment in full (see page 4).
- Historic boats on Canal & River Trust waterways claiming the 10% discount should contact Customer Services Centre who will calculate the value of your discount on your Gold Licence for you it is a complicated formula as the 10% can only be applied to the Canal & River Trust element of your Gold Licence.

Surcharges

- Continuous Cruisers incur a 10% surcharge.
- Boats with a beam over 2.16m but less than 3.24m 13% surcharge.
- Boats with a beam over 3.24m 26% surcharge.

Payment methods

- · Visa, Mastercard
- Direct Debit

Instalments are split equally between the number of months requested. The prompt payment discount is not available for instalment payments, but is already included in the payment in full (see page 4).

• Cheques made payable to Canal & River Trust.

What requirements are there?

- A valid Boat Safety Scheme Certificate or Declaration of Conformity with the Recreational Craft Directive. The latter must include the boat specifications and your declaration. If your boat is an open vessel powered solely by an outboard engine and it has no appliances for cooking, heating, refrigeration or lighting, it will probably be exempt from this requirement – ask us for an exemption form and enclose it with your Gold Licence application.
- Proof that you have third party liability insurance cover in place for a minimum of £2 million.
- Registration documents issued by relevant navigation authorities must be carried aboard your vessel.
- Once you have obtained your Gold Licence, whether it be by email or by post, you must display the discs on both sides of your vessel. Please remember to remove any old licence discs.

Where can I use the Gold Licence?

A full list of waterways is printed (see page 3).

What do I need to remember when I'm cruising?

First, and foremost: Enjoy the waterways! You'll also need to make sure you're keeping to the boat licence terms and conditions of Canal & River Trust (the Trust) or the requirements of the Environment Agency (EA) when you're on their waterways. This will be particularly relevant if you don't have a home mooring when on the Trust's waterways, where you'll need to meet the guidance for boaters without a home mooring. Cruising carried out on EA waterways will not be considered in your Trust licence review.

There is other helpful information on the Trust and EA (gov.uk) websites.

Access keys

A single key fits all Canal ϑ River Trust sanitary facilities, locks ϑ swing bridges, and a handcuff key is also required to open some of the locks on Canal ϑ River Trust navigations.

They are available from Canal & River Trust Customer Services Centre, waterway offices, chandlers and on-line at canalrivertrust.org.uk/shop

A separate key is needed for the EA's Anglian Waterways, available from the EA. T 03708 506 506 (Monday-Friday, 8am-6pm).

Safe and responsible boating

You must familiarise yourself with and follow the regulations set by each navigation authority. For a copy of the Boaters' Handbook, contact Canal & River Trust Customer Services Centre or any Canal & River Trust or EA office.

Temporary restrictions

Please check **canalrivertrust.org.uk/notices** for stoppage information before travel. Canal & River Trust's main repair programme runs from October to April.

Gold licence fees for narrowboats and craft less than 2.16m wide, 2026 20% VAT

If your boat is wider than this, then a surcharge will be applied.

Fees include VAT where applicable. Price is the same for powered and unpowered craft.

Deduct 25% if your boat has a permanently fitted inboard electric motor.

NB - Continuous Cruiser will incur a 10% surcharge, boats more than 2.16 but less than

3.24m wide will incur 13% surcharge and if over 3.24m the surcharge is 26%
