NOTIFICATION OF A BOAT'S HOME MOORING OR CRUISES CONTINUOUSLY

It is a condition of your licence when keeping a boat on our waterways that it has a home mooring - somewhere it can lawfully be left whilst not cruising. The only exceptions to this are:-

- (a) if the boat cruises continuously (without staying in any one place for more than 14 days) in accordance with the British Waterways Act 1995; or
- (b) if the boat is removed from our water when it is not being used for cruising.
