

Fishery Rules Boddington:

- Barbless hooks only
- Single hook rigs only (except pike fishing)
- No braided mainline (except spod, marker or pike fishing)
- All nets, slings and unhooking mats must be dry before fishing
- Landing net required and of appropriate size
- Unhooking mat or cradle must be used when fishing for specimen fish (carp, pike etc)
- No keepnets (except in authorised matches)
- One rod per permit. Maximum of 2 rods (April 1st to September 30th). Three rods permitted (October 1st to March 31st - at bailiffs' discretion).
- No tiger nuts, peanuts or cork to be used
- No night fishing
- Fishing from designated pegs only
- No fishing in unauthorised areas (if unsure check with bailiff)
- No swimming
- All fish to be returned to the water from which it came from
- Pike fishing from 1st October to 31st March only. (Two rod maximum)
- No drugs or alcohol
- No fires or BBQ's (cooking stoves are permitted)
- All litter to be taken home or put in bins provided
- Parking in accordance with signs and bailiff instructions
- Parents or guardians to accompany and supervise children at all times
