

Photo Competition – Share Your Love

Competition details and terms and conditions

1. The subject for the photographs is the Caen Hill Flight.

The aim of the photography competition is to focus on the magnificent engineering of the Caen Hill flight of locks. Photographs can have been taken any time of the year but must focus on the Caen Hill Flight of locks.

2. The winning photograph from the competition will be turned into a postcard to be available from May 2018.

3. This Competition is open to all aged 18 or over, except those who at any time between the start date and the date on which the Competition takes place (inclusive) are employees or volunteers of Canal & River Trust ('the Promoter') or any of its subsidiaries, their families or those otherwise associated with organising this Competition.

4. You may submit a maximum of three photographs.

5. Images must not have been previously published elsewhere.

6. If your image of the Caen Hill Lock Flight includes clearly recognisable individuals, we ask that you provide proof of permission from the individuals involved, for use of the image.

7. All entries must be sent in with a completed entry form attached. Entries should be in colour and produced in a 6x4 format and latterly available in a digital format. On the completed entry forms you submit with your photograph, you will need to tick the box accepting that you have read the competition details and agree to the terms and conditions.

8. All entries to be brought to the Admiral Welcome Boat located below Lock 44 of the Caen Hill flight **between 10 February and 18 February 2018**. Please put a sticker on the back of your image with the photo title and your full name.

9. Images submitted into this competition may be used in promotions, advertising and for educational purposes, by the Canal and River Trust. All other rights remain with the photographer. Even if you do not win the photography competition, by entering into the competition you give the Canal & River Trust permission, for an unlimited period, to use the photographs you enter, for promotions, advertising and educational purposes. You give us this permission without us having to make any payment to you for such use. We acknowledge that you will remain the owner of the copyright in the photographs. We will remove any photographs that do not meet the entry criteria or are deemed inappropriate.

10. All entries will be displayed on The Admiral between 18 February 2018 to 15 April 2018 during which time visitors will be invited to vote on their favourite which will be chosen to be printed as the postcard.

12. Canal & River Trust reserves the right to cancel this competition at any stage.

13. The competition shall be judged in accordance with paragraph 9 above and verified by the Promoter. The judge's decision is final and no correspondence will be entered in to.

14. Privacy Notice:

- (i) We confirm that the photograph/s you submit will only be used for the purposes specified in condition 9 above.
- (ii) We will be receiving the personal information supplied by you and personal information relating to a parent or guardian: names, age (if applicable), email address.
- (iii) We will only use the personal information referred to in (ii) above to communicate with you on matters relating to the competition and to enable us to run the competition.
- (iv) The name of the competition winner will be announced as stated in condition 9.
- (v) Your personal information will only come to the attention of Canal & River Trust staff and the Lead Volunteer for the Admiral who are involved in managing the competition and our publicity activities relating to the use of photographs that were entered for the competition.
- (vi) We will only hold on to your personal information for as long as we need it in connection with running the competition, and after the competition, only for so long as we choose to use your photographs for purposes specified.
- (vii) If we no longer need to have a record of your personal details, we will delete them.

- (ix) We must comply with our obligations under the Data Protection Act 1998 and ensure that we only use and hold your personal data in accordance with the law.
