## Fishery Rules Naseby (from January 1<sup>st</sup> 2024)

- Micro barbed hooks only
- Single hook rigs only (except pike fishing)
- No braided mainlines (except spod, marker or pike fishing)
- Minimum 15lb breaking strain line
- No bait boats
- No drones
- No radios or speaker type devices
- No fixed leads
- No auto hooking devices such as the 'Magic Twig'
- All nets must be dry before fishing. If not, then the net dip station on site must be used
- 42" Landing net required
- Suitably sized, large, padded unhooking mat or cradle must be used
- No keepnets
- 3 rod limit for carp fishing. 2 rod limit for pike fishing
- To maintain access, only small 1man bivvies permitted on the dam wall
- No particle baits. Boilies and pellet only
- Fishing from designated pegs only
- Wellies or waders always required due to fluctuations in water levels
- No swimming
- No open fires
- No guns
- All fish to be returned to the reservoir
- Pike fishing from 1<sup>st</sup> October to 31<sup>st</sup> March only
- No livebaits to be used
- Well behaved dogs are allowed but must be under control at all times. All dog waste to be removed from site
- No drugs or excessive drinking (Bailiffs decision is final)
- Raised BBQs and cooking stoves permitted. No BBQs on wooden walkways or platforms

- All litter to be taken home. A zero-tolerance policy is enforced. Anyone leaving litter will be barred. Peg inspections will be carried out spontaneously
- Parking in accordance with signs and bailiff instructions
- Arriving or setting up after dark is not permitted (unless angler is season permit holder)
- Minimum age 16 to fish unless accompanied by an adult. Parents and guardians to supervise children at all times
- No 3<sup>rd</sup> party events or activities permitted without prior permission
