


Create and Do: The Written Word

Print out and mock up the word catcher. Use it to capture your thoughts.

Once it is completed you can turn it into a fun 'fortune telling' game to reveal words and phrases to inspire your writing. You can also print out a blank one (see next page) and decorate it yourself with your own words and phrases.

How to make a word catcher

- Print and cut out around the outside of the word catcher
- 2 Fold in half and half again
- Open out, turn over so top is blank and fold each corner into the middle
- 4 Turn over and repeat
- 5 Turn over so you can see the coloured squares
- 6 Slide your thumb and your finger behind two of the coloured squares and press together so they bend round and touch
- 7 Turn over and repeat with the thumb and finger of the other hand for the other two coloured squares
- 8 All the coloured squares should now be at the front with centres touching and you are ready to use your word catcher
