Drayton Reservoir fishery rules

- Barbless hooks only
- Single hook rigs only (except pike fishing)
- Coated braid hook lengths permitted
- No braided main line (except spod, marker or pike fishing)
- No bait boats
- All nets must be dry before fishing
- Landing net required and of appropriate size
- Unhooking mat or cradle must be used
- No keepnets
- Maximum of 2 rods
- No nuts
- Seasonal opening times please check with bailiff
- Day and night fishing available
- Receivers required for bite alarms when night fishing on righthand side of the lake
- Fish welfare is a priority no standing with fish
- Fishing from designated pegs only
- No swimming
- All fish to be returned to the water from which they came
- Pike fishing from 1 October to 31 March only
- No drugs or alcohol
- No fires or barbecues (cooking stoves are permitted)
- All litter to be placed in the bin or taken home
- No dogs
- Please park at an angle, as signed on dam wall. No parking in adjacent housing estate.
