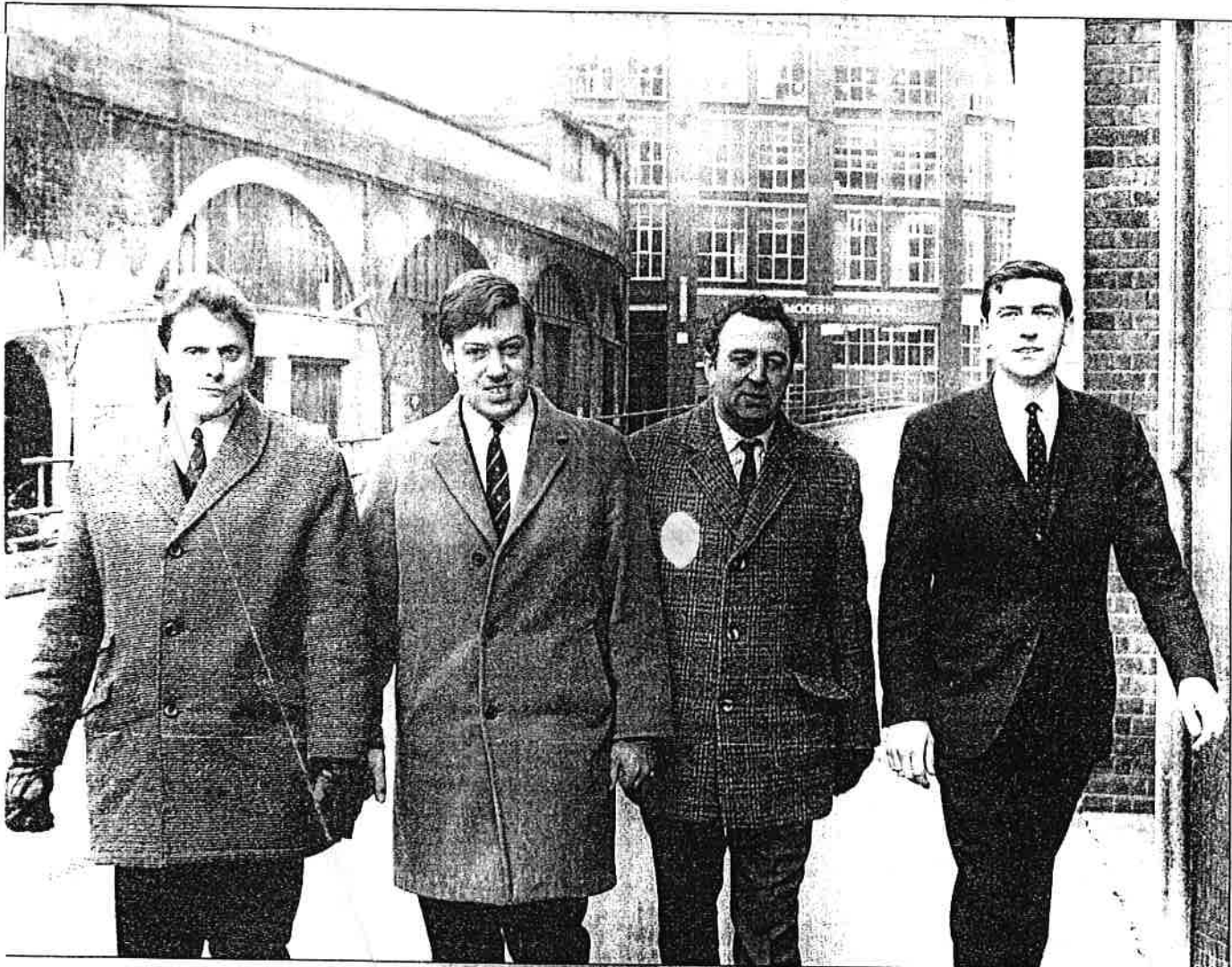

This photograph was taken outside the Old Bailey at the start of the Kray trial in 1969 and depicts four of the officers involved: George McKye, George Ness, Tom Thorburn and Terry Mansbridge, from the left. Sender Tom Thorburn retired from the Met in 1975 after 25 years service as a DS on M, C8, C8, H and K — surely some of the most exciting CID postings in the 1960s.
