

Where does the water come from?

Water at Lapworth Locks comes south from the North Stratford Canal. The closest source of water at this location is Earlswood Lakes.

Water also comes from Rotton Park Reservoir in Birmingham and Upper Bittell and Cofton Reservoirs near Alvechurch.

From Lock 22 down, water may also come from Olton Reservoir on the Ten Mile Pound of the Grand Union Canal upstream of Knowle Locks.

Earlswood Lakes

Earlswood Lakes consist of three reservoirs: Engine, Windmill and Terry's Pools

Lapworth Locks are a flight of 26 Locks on the North and South Stratford Canals

Locks 19 and 23 were used over 2000 times each in 2019
