

Where does the water come from?



Some of the water at Brentford comes down the Grand Union Canal from rivers further north ...

... but most is provided by the River Brent which joins the canal just below lock 97 on the Hanwell Flight

Between Lock 97 and the tidal River Thames at Brentford the River Brent is canalised ...

... with locks linking navigable sections, and side loops representing the original course of the river

The tidal range of the River Thames can be as much as 7 metres at a spring tide
