- Actual lock penning times vary depending on a number of factors including weather conditions, river level and predicted tide
 height. As a general guide passage Naburn to Selby/Goole is 2 hours before high-water at Naburn. Passage Selby to Naburn is
 at or close to start of flood at Selby. Passage time Selby to Goole can be at the start of ebb or high water depending on a
 number of factors.

- Locks are not manned before 06:00hrs or after 22:00hrs.
- All times quoted above are local times and have been adjusted to BST where appropriate.
