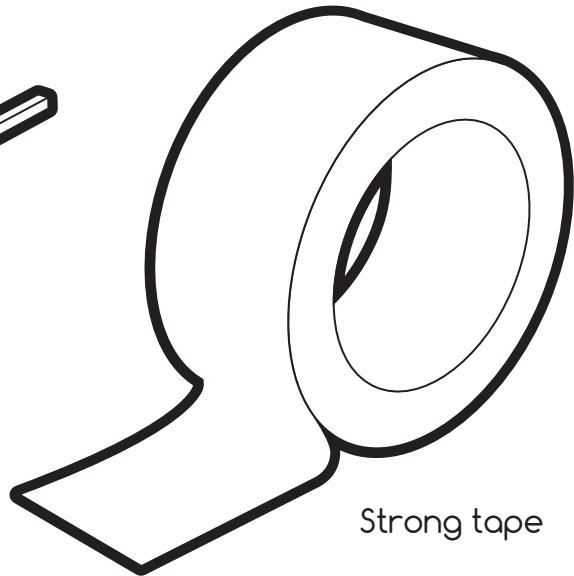
Pipe cleaner



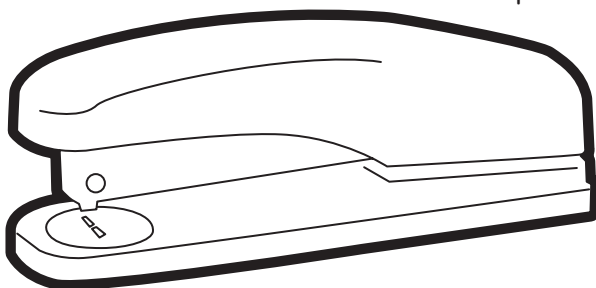
Anaglypta wall paper



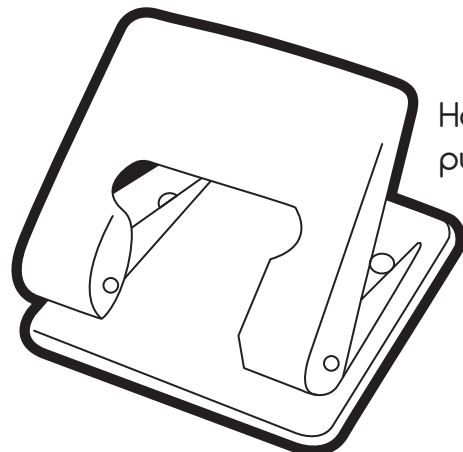
2 Pea sticks

Stapler

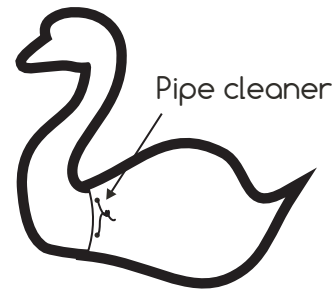


Hole punch

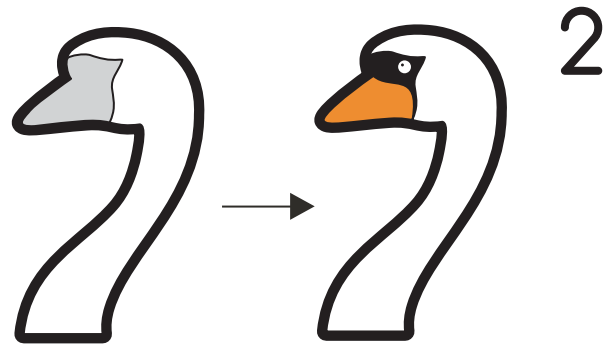
Fun things to do: page 3 of 5

Cut out shapes A and B from your swan template. Draw around them on to card and cut out. Ask an adult to help you punch out the holes with the hole punch on both shapes. Attach shapes A and B together with a pipe cleaner.



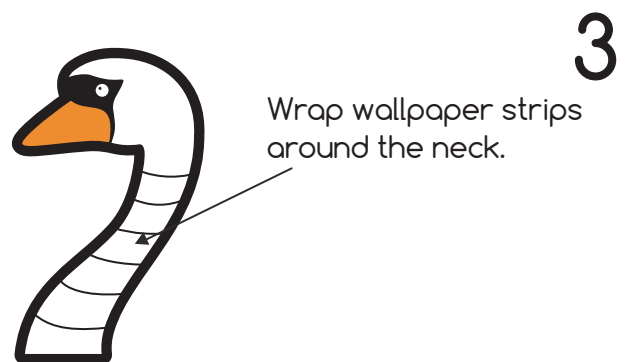
Cut out template C. This is the face of the swan. Draw around it on to white card. Colour this black with an orange beak. Remember to draw an eye.

Glue this on top of shape A as shown.

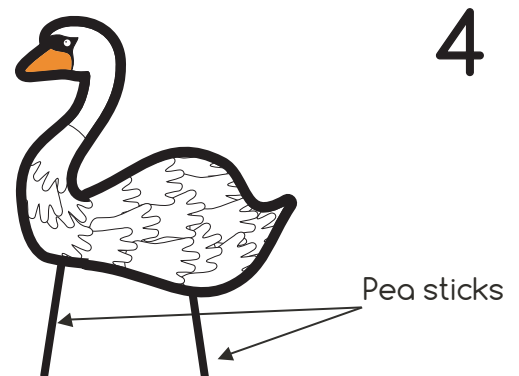


Cut six 10cm by 5cm strips of wallpaper and wrap them around the neck.

Glue in place to give a 3D effect.

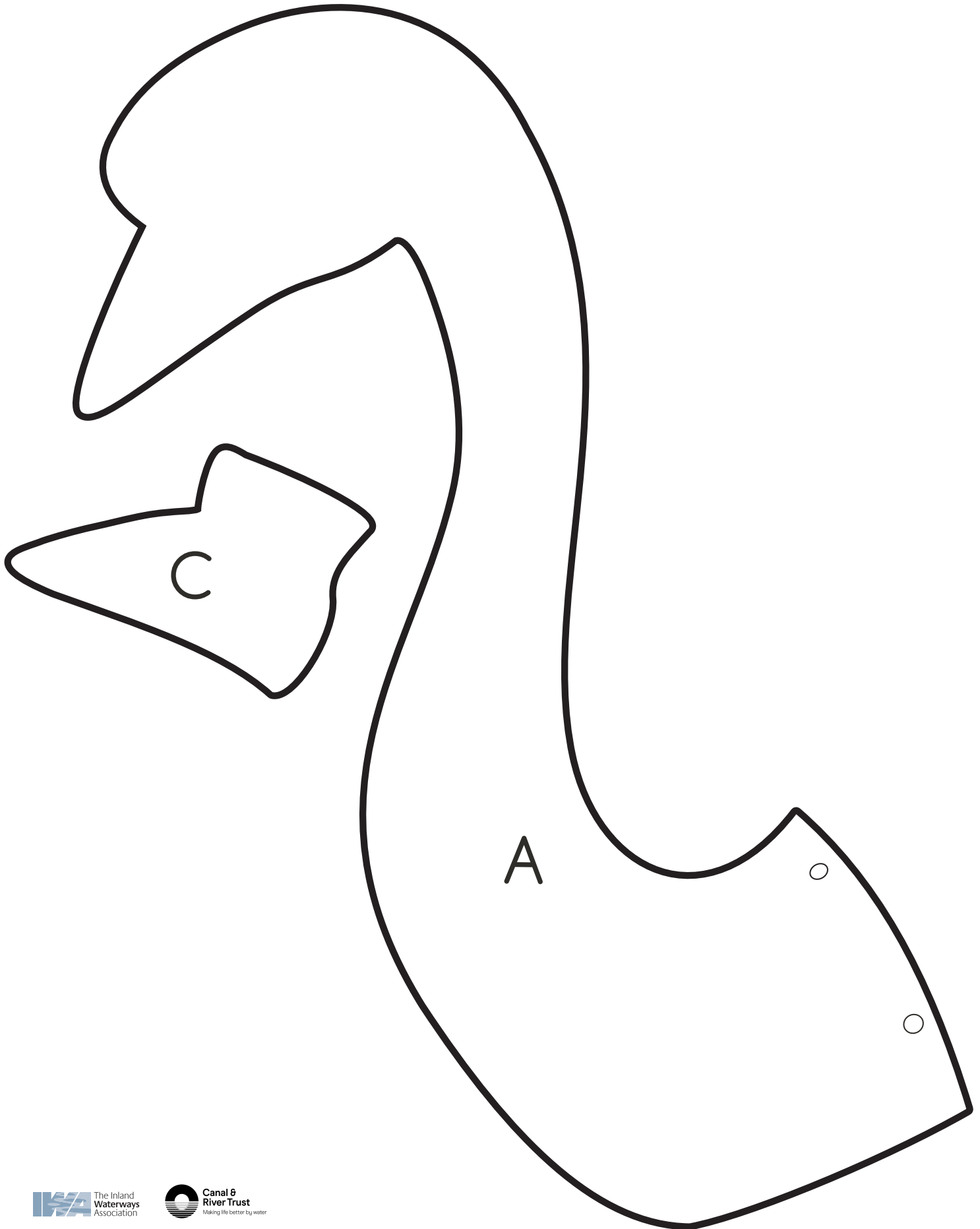


Draw around your hand (not including the thumb) on to the wallpaper. Repeat this 15 - 20 times. Cut out the shapes. Glue or staple each hand to the body to make the feathers. Attach 2 pea sticks to the back of the body to make a puppet.
