

Narrowboat Art. (KS1)



Curriculum links:

Art and Design – 2b, 2c, 4b, 5b, 5c, 5d.

Key Skills: Improving own learning and performance.

Learning Objectives

All: Develop a technique in order to create a piece of narrow boat art. State what is good about another students work.

Most: Be able to state who boat people were. Use different techniques and materials. Point out areas for improvement in the work of others.

Some: Give reasons why narrow boat cabins were decorated. Work with others to improve their work.

A creative activity using art to teach the crafts, customs and social history of the boat people. Participants decorate a full-size reproduction of a narrow boat cabin with items that they have made during the course of the activity.
