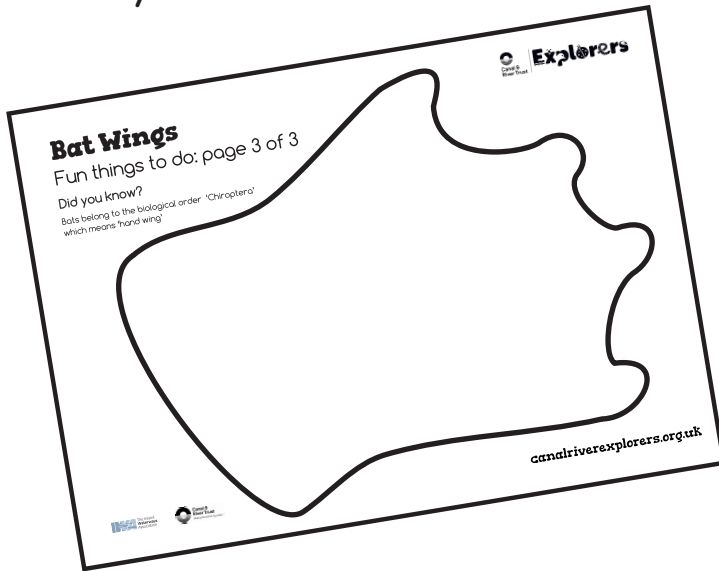


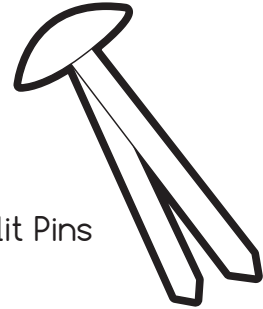
Bat Wings

Fun things to do: page 1 of 3

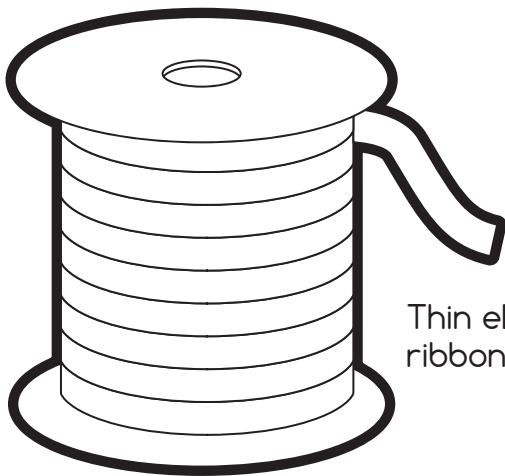
What you need



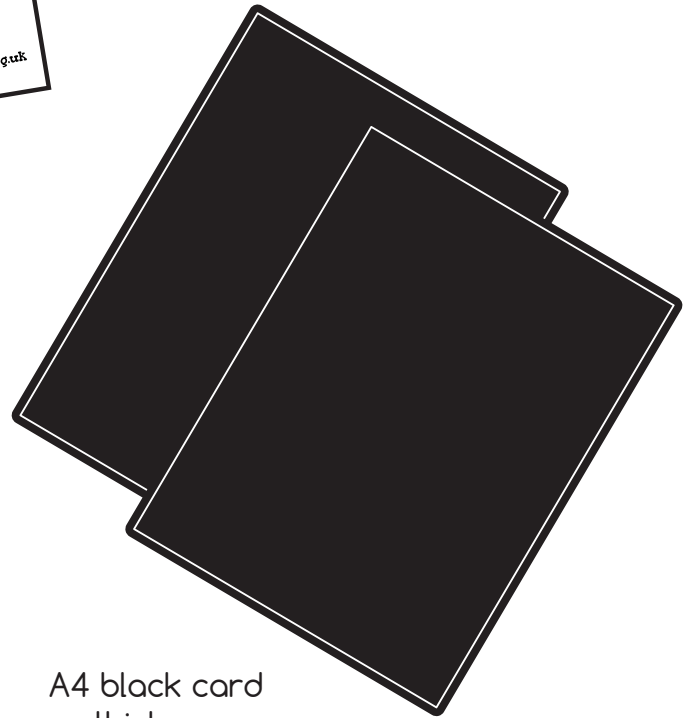
Bat Wings
template sheet



Split Pins



Thin elastic
ribbon



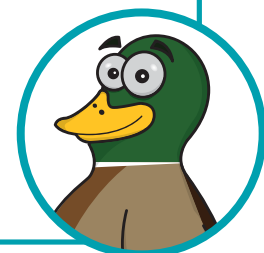
A4 black card
or thick paper.

Top Tips

Make sure you fold the points of the split pins back to avoid catching on your clothing.

You could decorate your batwings, using glitter or silver and gold paints.

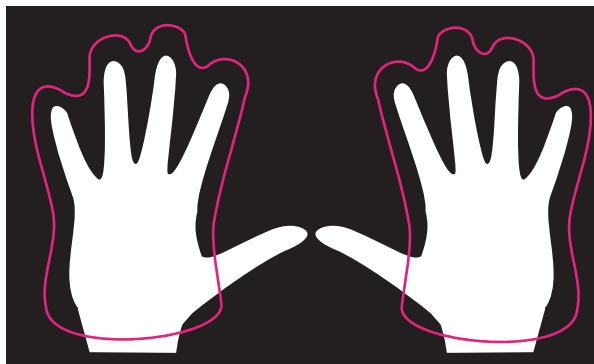
Cut out the template and draw round it to produce the wing shape on black card. Remember that you will need 2 wings.

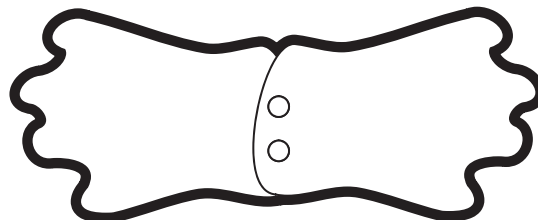
Fun things to do: page 2 of 3

Either cut out the template shapes in black card - one for each wing, or draw round your hand (the template will give you larger batwings!)



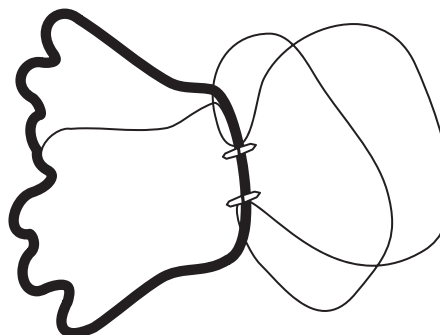

Fasten the two 'wings' together with split pins.

Take a length of elastic and push the points of the split pins through them to form 2 loops.
