

# Summary Terms & Conditions

## Casual and Visitor Towpath Moorings in Stoke Bruerne

The towpath between Blisworth Tunnel and the water point near Lock 20 is divided into zones reflecting their relative popularity and proximity to local pubs, the Museum and other services. Time limits are signed on towpath posts along the towpath verge and explanatory signs are located at either end of the length.

The signed time limits indicate the maximum length of stay within a zone during any one visit. Additionally, there is a limit to the total number of days your boat may spend within the area in any one visit and also in any one calendar month, without payment.

An extended stay charge of £25 (including VAT) per day applies if:

- your boat does not move on after the maximum stay time in a zone for a single visit, or
- your boat does not move on after 7 consecutive days in the mooring area, or
- your boat spends more than 14 days in total in the mooring area in any one calendar month.

This charge reflects our costs of keeping the visitor moorings available.

Holiday Hire boats displaying a valid business licence will be exempt from the number of visits in a calendar month limit but must adhere to all other conditions.

Roving Traders displaying a valid business licence may stay in a two day zone for four days but must adhere to all other conditions. Breasted up trade boats count as one on a visitor mooring, but boats that travel as a pair (motor and butty) **MUST** remain breasted up as a pair on a 2 day visitor mooring (where space permits).

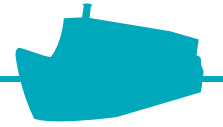
Mooring Rangers record daily the index number, date, time and location of each moored boat. This information is the basis for the calculation of extended stay charges.

Reasonable efforts will be made to contact the boat's licence holder to give warning and notification of extended stay charges. It is however your responsibility to keep track of the time limit and move on without waiting for a notification.

Extended stay charges will be invoiced monthly and recorded on your boat licence account. Your account must be paid in full within 28 days. Debts will be recovered through our normal processes which may include obtaining a County Court judgment.

# Welcome to Stoke Bruerne

## We hope you enjoy your stay

The map in this leaflet shows the various mooring zones in the Stoke Bruerne mooring area between Blisworth Tunnel and the welcome signs below the towpath footbridge (bridge 54b) on the Grand Union Canal. They include 2 day and 7 day moorings – look for the signs on the towpath posts.

Mooring in the zones is free for the published time. An extended stay charge of £25 (including VAT) per day applies if ...

- you do not move on after the maximum stay time within any one of the zones in the Stoke Bruerne mooring area.
- you stay longer than 7 consecutive days in the Stoke Bruerne mooring area, or
- you spend more than 14 days in the Stoke Bruerne mooring area

during any calendar month.

The area is visited daily by visitor mooring rangers, volunteering on behalf of the Canal & River Trust, who record your boat number. Extended stay charges will be invoiced monthly and recorded on your boat licence account.

Longer stay times may apply during Winter (1st November – 31 March). Please check the stay times on the towpath posts.

Please respect the mooring zones they are design to ensure mooring space is shared fairly between all.

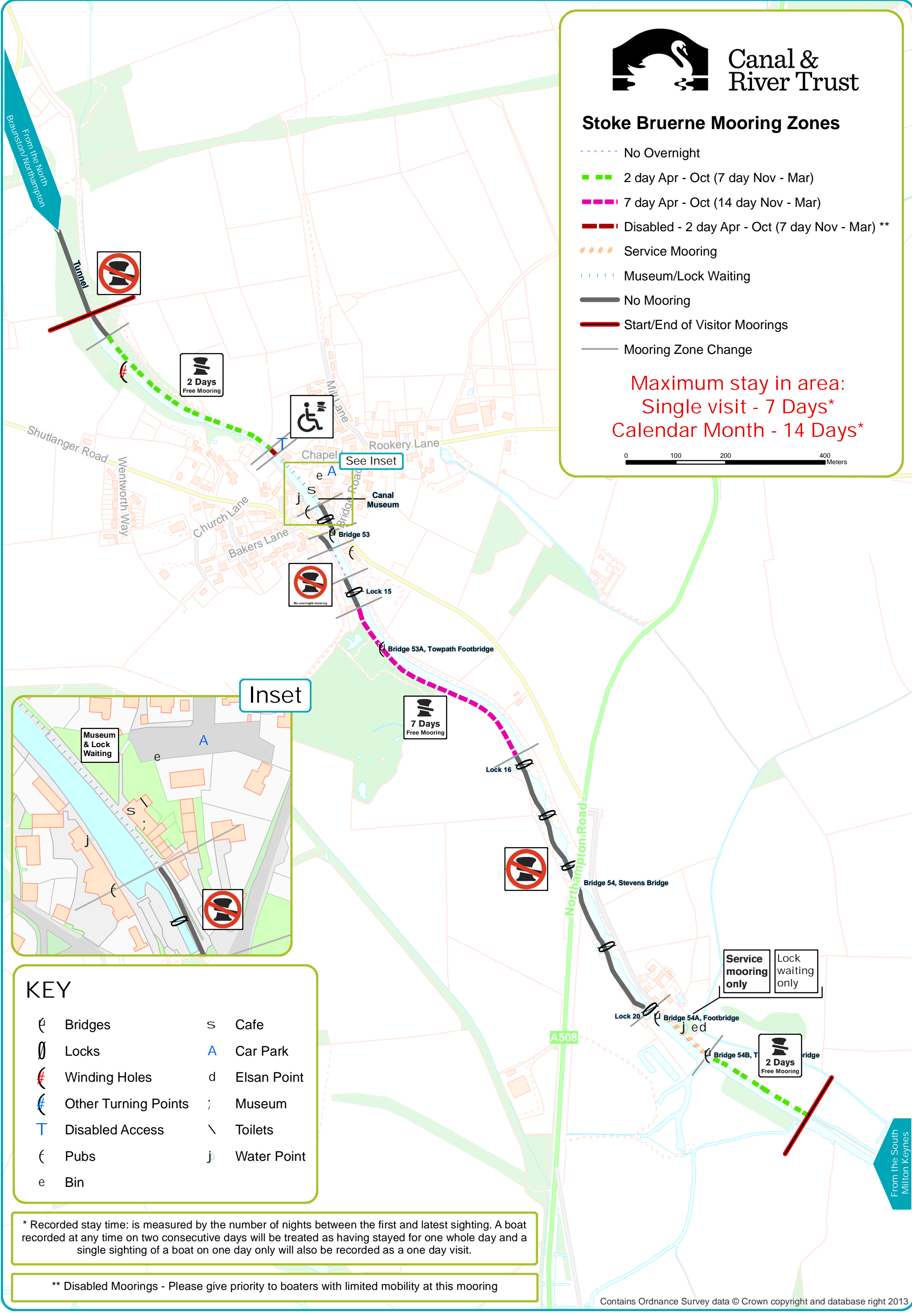

\* Recorded stay time: is measured by the number of nights between the first and latest sighting. A boat recorded at any time on two consecutive days will be treated as having stayed for one whole day and a single sighting of a boat on one day only will also be recorded as a one day visit.
