



Classification of stoppage types

Type of stoppage	Explanation
(Re)Construction	Planned or programmed works to build or rebuild an asset
3rd Party Works	Works or activities undertaken by others on Trust land or property
Boat Damage	Structural damage to a Trust asset caused by boat impact in a single event involving one or more boats
Inspection	Investigatory activities into the condition of a Trust asset
Maintenance	Planned or programmed works to maintain the serviceability of a Trust asset
Police / Emergency Services Incident	A situation or event where the Trust is directed in its actions by the Police or emergency services
Repair	Works or activities to reinstate the functionality or serviceability of an asset
Asset Failure	Unforeseen failure of an asset in service
Vandalism /Misuse	Deliberate, malicious act causing damage or destruction to a Trust asset or property or incorrect use of a Trust asset or property causing damage or loss of serviceability
Vegetation	Closures or restrictions caused by plants or trees
Water Resources	Insufficient water supplies as a result of Trust acts or omissions
Vehicle Strike	Structural damage to a Trust asset caused by vehicular impact
Flooding	High water levels or flow that make navigation unsafe
Drought	Insufficient water for navigation cause by weather or other imposed restrictions
Environmental / Pollution Incident	A closure or restriction to prevent possible harm to people, wildlife or the environment
Information	General advice to customers that is not the primary notification of a closure or restriction
Event	A gathering of people, craft or other occasion that will cause a restriction or closure
