



Getting Started

Install  **Explorer for ArcGIS** from the CRT App Store.

Once the app has finished installing open it and select “**Continue Without Signing In**”.

Tap  the green bar at the top of the screen and the Main Menu will appear.

Select  **Find Maps** and type **CRT**. Select *CRT Asset Explorer* from the list. This will now be your default map and will appear every time you reopen the app.

Using the App


The map is fully interactive. You can select an item on the screen and additional details will appear. You can pinch to zoom and drag the map to pan. Additional layers of information will become visible as you zoom in.






The display for an Android device and an iOS device is slightly different please check the [ESRI website](#) for clarification on the layout for your device.

Please note: wifi or a phone signal is required to use this application. If using this in the field please keep your data usage in mind as this will affect the mobile device charges.

The tool bar at the bottom of the map allows you to see the legend and turn layers on and off, turn on the GPS (to enable the GPS, you must turn on Location Services, found in your device's settings), and search for features and assets.



You can also expand the tool bar to show additional functionality by selecting the menu button on the bottom of your phone (left button on an Android phone or the  on the TC55).

 Bookmarks	Pre-set to each of the 10 Waterway Units
 Measure	Open the Measure toolbar which allows distances and areas to be measured
 Sketch	Create sketches on the map which can be shared as screen shots
 Basemaps	Used to change the background map (aerial photos available)
 Share	Email screen shots of maps (including GPS position and sketches)
