- 2. Introductions All members introduced themselves

6. Matters arising

- 6.1. Chantelle to contact Tim Webber to confirm he is co-opted and welcome to attend meetings. *Action CS.*

- 6.3. Chantelle confirmed that the Liverpool Canal Link consultation outcomes paper had been circulated to all responding. From 1 August we will pilot, to the end of the season, 'in' and 'out' passages on each operational day. Passages will commence from Stanley Top Lock opening up canal from Hancock's Swing Bridge. Hancock's is being discussed with Sefton Council. Chantelle to update progress next meeting. *Action CS.*

- 10.4. Mike Macklin updated on progress. 18 adoptions achieved against target of 10. Partnership expressed concerns about adoption signs and asked Chantelle to feed back to marketing team. Focus should be on the company adopting and not on the word 'adopted'. Would like 'cared for' to be used. Chantelle confirmed that as DEM had not been appointed that Alice Kay would assist with two adoptions per month for next two months. Action CS

New mooring times will be signed before start of season, environmental survey being undertaken, enforcement improved considerably, meeting with Lancaster University agreed. Good feedback from Local Waterway Forum at last 2 meetings. Frances Done congratulated the Partnership on an innovative project and good example of close working between Partnership and staff.
- 10.9. Peter Jordan updated on this year 2 project with a proposal to increase use of towpath including housing association well-being initiative. Agreed that Peter and Richard Atkinson would meet with Chantelle to scope project *Action PJ/RA/CS*
- 10.10. Richard Atkinson to be asked to provide an update on the Coast to Coast Canoe Trail project which has now secured £1.3m funding *Action CS*
- 10.11. Chantelle confirmed that when the business plan is agreed signage reviews will be undertaken within available funding. *Action CS*
- 10.12. Peter Rowlinson confirmed that he is progressing an idea for construction heritage skills training. *Action PR*
