
A note about the data

Locks & bridges

Ashton Canal

Lock 1 through to lock 18: We advise that passage should commence before 10am on this flight.

Lumb Lane Bridge, Br21: Bridge is very low (6ft). Please remove your chimney.

Huddersfield Narrow Canal

Lock 1W, Ashton Lock: Handcuff key and windlass required. Bottom gates operated by hydraulic pumps. Between Locks 1W and 2W, there is a 175-yard narrow channel known as Whitelands Tunnel. Please give way to craft travelling downstream. Peak Forest Canal Bridge 1, Stanley Lift Bridge: Handcuff key required.
