
A note about the data

Navigation notes

Restriction on lift of paddle gear in is place on some paddles to assist low water flows.

Morse Lock to Norwood Tunnel: Maximum guaranteed width is 6ft 10.5in.

West Stockwith to tail of Morse Lock:
Locks up to Refford are 15ft wide but

Locks up to Retford are 15ft wide but navigation for broad-beam craft is restricted by Manor Farm Bridge at Walkeringham, which is 8ft 6in wide.

Locks & bridges

Norwood Tunnel – East Portal: End of navigation, tunnel sealed.

Lock 20, Top Treble Lock 1: T handle key required.

Bridge 35, Plane Bridge:

Low arch height – proceed with caution.

Lock 41A, Boundary Lock:

Canal & River Trust key required.

Bridge 38, Shireoaks Bridge: Low bridge: proceed with caution. Max craft height 7ft 1in.

Lock 42, Shireoaks Top Lock; and Lock 43, Shireoaks Middle Lock; and Lock 44, Shireoaks Bottom Lock; and Lock 45, Doefield Dunn Lock; and Lock 46, Haggonfield Lock; and

Lock 47, Deep Lock:

Canal & River Trust key required.

Lock 48, Stret Lock:

Canal & River Trust key required. Narrowlock. Max craft width 6ft 10.5in.

Lock 49, Morse Lock:

Canal & River Trust key required.

Lock 50, Worksop Town Lock:

Canal & River Trust key required. Listed lock.

Lock 51, Bracebridge Lock:

Canal & River Trust key required.

Worksop Aqueduct:

Narrow aqueduct - single-file traffic.

Lock 52. Kilton Lock:

Canal & River Trust key required.
Anti vandal cover to prevent water loss.

Lock 53, Osberton Lock:

Canal & River Trust key required.





 Maximum during daylight. No over
 night stay. Total 50 metres.
- 4 Shireoaks Marina:
 Maximum 24 hours. Total 85 metres.
- Cuckoo Wharf, Worksop: Maximum 24 hours. Total 100 metres.
- Below Cuckoo Wharf, Worksop: Maximum 24 hours. Total 100 metres.

Slipways 8 docks

4 Shireoaks Marina: Slipway. Maximum length: 70ft. Maximum beam: 6ft 10.5in. Book through Canal θ River Trust, tel: 03030 404040.

Locks & bridges

Chesterfield Canal

Lock 54, Forest Top Lock:

Canal & River Trust key required.

Lock 55, Forest Middle Top Lock:

Canal & River Trust key required. Bubble barrier in place to deter fish.

Lock 56, Forest Middle Bottom Lock; and **Lock 57, Forest Bottom Lock**; and

Lock 58, West Retford Lock: Canal & River Trust key required.

Retford Aqueduct:

. Width restriction – single craft only.

Lock 59, Retford Town Lock:

Canal & River Trust key required.

Tunnel 73, Drakeholes Tunnel:

Headlights required, safety chain in place.

Lock 60, Whitsunday Pie Lock:

Canal & River Trust key required.

Bridge 60, Whitsunday Pie Bridge: End of SSSI.

Lock 61, Gringley Top Lock; and Lock 62, Shaw Lock:

Canal & River Trust key required.

Bridge 77, Smith's Bridge: Low bridge proceed with caution, max craft height 7'6".

Bridge 80, Cooper's Bridge: Start of SSSI.

Bridge 82, Swallow Bridge: Listed bridge.

Lock 63, Misterton Top Lock; and Lock 64, Misterton Low Lock:

Canal & River Trust key required.

Lock 65, West Stockwith Lock: Care and advice must be taken when entering or leaving the Tidal Trent at West Stockwith.

West Stockwith Basin:

Canal & River Trust key required.

- 3 Clayworth: Water, Elsan disposal, toilet, refuse disposal. Canal θ River Trust key required. Card type: None.
- 6 Forest Middle Top lock: Water, Elsan disposal, pump-out, toilet, shower, refuse disposal. Canal θ River Trust key required. Card type: Ampy.
- 10 West Stockwith Lock: Water, Elsan disposal, pump-out, toilet, shower, refuse disposal. Canal θ River Trust key required. Card type: Ampy.

- Drakeholes Basin: Maximum 24 hours. Total 100 metres.
- 4 Hayton: Maximum 24 hours. Total 21 metres.
- Gate Inn, Clarborough:

 Maximum 24 hours. Total 50 metres.
- 6 Forest Middle Top lock: Maximum 24 hours. Total 100 metres.
- 7 Hop Pole Pub, Retford: Maximum 24 hours. Total 100 metres.
- 8 Packet Inn, Retford: Maximum 24 hours. Total 50 metres.
- 9 Retford above and below lock: Maximum 24 hours. Total 110 metres.
- 10 West Stockwith Lock: First 24 hours free.

Chesterfield Canal

- Retford Mariners Boat Club: Slipway. Maximum length: 70ft. Maximum beam: 7 ft. Book through Retford Mariners.
- 10 West Stockwith Basin: Slipway. Maximum length: 70ft. Book through the lock keepers. Winch available.
