Cadbury's chocolate 'Crumb' (milk, sugar and cocoa made into slabs) was carried between Ellesmere Port and the Cadbury's factory at Bourneville. Each load was 25 tons and the journey went through 50 locks, taking up to 14 hours. Boat children were sometimes allowed to drop a lump of the chocolate into hot milk to give them a warming treat on such a long journey!
